Club Tweed CODE OF CONDUCT

- 1. Any member of the Club Tweed who is participating in a Premier League, Premier 7's, State Pennants, District, State, interstate or international bowls event must comply with the provisions of the Conditions of Play and By-laws of the QLD Bowling Association, the Conditions of Play and the Rules of the Club and the Laws of the Sport of Bowls and must conduct themselves in a spirit of fair play and good sportsmanship.
- 2. Any member who represents the Club in any bowls event and/or as a member of the Club participates in any bowls event and any member who attends such event(s) as a spectator must not engage in conduct which is violent, aggressive, inappropriate or prejudicial to the interests of the Club. Inappropriate behaviour can include unbecoming conduct inside or outside THBC Ltd or through all forms of social media.
- 3. Any member who is defeated after participating in the Club's Major Singles or Minor Singles (B Grade) Championships must be available to mark in the following round of that event. Failure to comply will render such member ineligible to participate in any singles event within the Club in the following year.
- 4. Any member who has indicated his/her availability to represent the Club in any Premier League, Premier 7's, State Pennants season must play in the position(s) and team(s) as selected from week to week by the Club's selectors.
- 5. Any member who so indicates his/her availability but who indicates his/her unavailability for any round(s) of that premier league, premier 7's, pennants season must provide the reason(s) therefore to the Chairman of selectors.
- 6. Any member who is selected to represent the Club in any round(s) of the pennants season but who withdraws from his/her selected team must provide the reason(s) therefore to the Chairman of selectors.
- 7. Should the Club's selectors determine that the reason(s) provided by any member for his/her unavailability for or his/her withdrawal from any round(s) of the premier league /premier 7's. pennants season is or are unacceptable that member will be ineligible for selection in any team representing the Club for the following two (2) rounds of competition either in that season or the following season.
- 8. Should any member be unavailable or withdraw from a selected team on the grounds of an unwillingness to travel to another Club or because of dissatisfaction with his/her selected position or team, the Club's selectors will regard any such reason(s) as unacceptable thereby rendering that member ineligible for selection for the following two (2) rounds of pennants competition either in that season or the following season.
- 9. Any member who is dissatisfied with a decision of the Club's selectors in relation to ineligibility for any round(s) of any pennants season(s) may appeal in writing to the relevant Sub Club Executive Committee of the Club Tweed.
