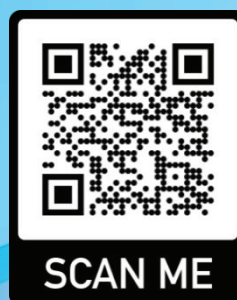

# 2024 Tweed Open Premier Singles

## The Draw

The Open draw is conducted on arrival for sectional play at 8.15am in Bowlers Lounge for Sunday and Monday's play

## Conditions of Play

The Controlling Body of the Tweed Open Premier Singles "TOPS" will be the THBC Tournament Committee Open Mixed Singles Event.

**Limited to 168 Players (84 Players for each Sectional Day)**

Dress code: BA-approved bowls attire or club uniform.

Open draw at 8.15am for Sectional Play for Day 1 & Day 2.

Each section will be made up of 3 players.

All games 21 shots up with dead ends replayed.

The Indoor Green may be used as required. Subsequent rounds may be transferred to the Indoor Green if required.

Each player will play 2 games of sectional play and **act as a marker for 1 game.**

The winner of the first game in sectional play marks the second game.

**Trial ends start at 8.45 am** daily and play commences forthwith. Further games commence as rinks become available.

One trial end each way with four bowls permitted before each game.

Players shall advise the name of their coach to THBC Tournament committee and Umpire prior to the match commencing.

The THBC Tournament Committee may use replacement players up to start of play.

Players will only be able to visit the head after their **third & fourth bowl (A.4.1)** is delivered. In exceptional and limited circumstances a player may ask the marker to visit the head earlier than this (Law A.4.2). Non-compliance will be addressed by Law 13.

The use of electronic receiving devices are not permitted within six metres of the green during play.

Bowls testing may be conducted at any time.

Three player sections with the sectional winner (as per Law 27 & Law 56.3.1.3) will go through to post sectional play.

If a bye/forfeit is in sectional play, a win + margin of that round will be allocated to the affected player.

**All Sectional winners will play 1 round of post sectional play that day once sectional play is completed.**

32 players will qualify for the post sectional play from both Sunday & Mondays sectional games. This will be made up of the sectional winners, and the next best players (with highest wins + margin) required to make up a round of 32 players

An Open Draw will be held for the last 32 players on Day 3 (Tuesday) at 8.15am to determine the draw.

Tournament Committee may fill the wildcard positions at their discretion.

Entry is open to all affiliated bowlers.

Bowls Australia Ranking Points event.

All meals are the responsibility of the players.

Players must be familiar with and accept all Conditions of Play.

All other laws will conform to the Laws of the sport of Lawn Bowls and Domestic Regulations.

Any bowler using an artificial device will have the necessary approved documentation.
