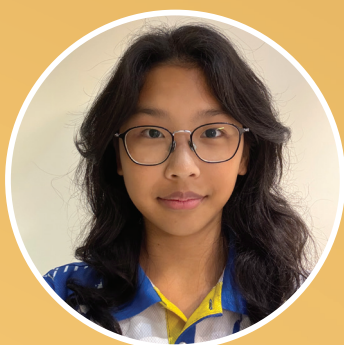

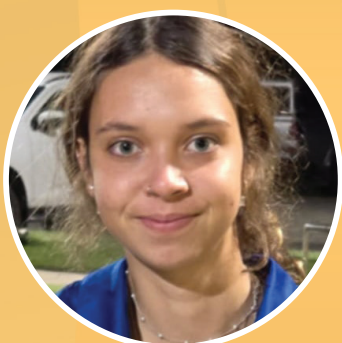

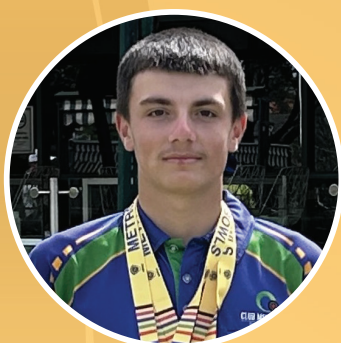

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. GAMES

All games will be played in accordance with the Laws of the Sport of Bowls (Crystal Mark), including Australian Domestic Regulations. The Controlling Body shall have absolute control over all facets of the tournament with the power to alter the Conditions of Play if necessary.

2. ATTIRE

Bowls club attire to worn both days.

3. SATURDAY

- 24 boys and 24 girls will compete in sectional play.
- 6 sections of 4 players each (for both boys and girls).
- Match format: 21 shots up (shots in excess of 21 will not count).

Scoring:

- 3 points for a win
- Trial ends start at 8.45am (one trial end each way, four bowls per player).
- Sectional play starts at 9.00am.

4. VISIT THE HEAD

Players may not visit the head until after the delivery of their third bowl (as per APPA.4).

5. CONTROLLING BODY

The Controlling Body has the power to approve replacement players up until the start of the tournament.

- Trial ends: One trial end each way of four bowls is allowed prior to the first game of the day. If a player has a bye in the first game, they are allowed two trial ends before their first match.

6. SUNDAY - FINALS FORMAT

- The 6 section winners and the next 2 best-performing runners-up (based on wins, shot difference, and percentage if needed) advance to the quarter-finals.

- Trial ends start at 8.45am (one trial end each way, four bowls per player).

Schedule:

- Quarter-finals start at 9.00am (21 shots up).
- Semi-finals start at 11.00am (21 shots up).
- Losing semi-finalists play off for 3rd and 4th place on Sunday at 2.00pm (21 shots up).
- Final starts at 2.00pm (21 shots up).

7. RE-SPOT THE JACK

Dead ends will not be replayed. The jack will be re-spotted on the 2-metre mark.

8. MANAGERS AND COACHES

Managers and coaches must register with the umpire and the tournament director before the game begins, as per Law 57.

9. MANAGERS AND COACHES

The highest number of games won determines section winners. If tied, the decision will be based on:

1. The highest number of **games points** scored will be ranked higher.
2. If game points are equal, the player with the **highest net total shots** over all games in the section (shots for minus shots against) will be ranked higher.
3. If game points and net total shots are equal, the Controlling Body will divide a player's total of shots for, by total of shots against to calculate a shot percentage. The player with the **highest shot percentage** will be ranked higher.
