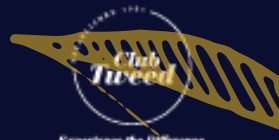

- The Organising Body of the Tweed Open Premier Singles (TOPS) will be the Club Tweed Bowls Association
- Open/Week Single Bowls
- Limited to 60 Players/60 Players for each Sectional Day
- Entry costs \$40 (includes GST, registration and green fees)
- Bowls Australia Ranking Points apply - Bowls Link Entry Required
- Open draw at 8.15am for Sectional Play for Day 1/2/3/4/5
- Trial ends from 8.45am (end of 1st/2nd/3rd/4th/5th)
- Each section will be made up of 15 players
- All sectional winners will play 1 round of post sectional play that day once sectional play is completed
- 15 players will qualify for the post sectional play from each Sunday or Monday's sectional games
- This will be made up of the sectional winners, and the next best players (with highest rank in Bowls Australia) in order up to a total of 15 players
- Post sectional play will play 1 round of post sectional play that day once sectional play is completed
- All games 21 overs or until dead ends required
- The Inaugural Draw may be used as required
- Subsequent rounds may be conducted to the Inaugural Draw (Preceded draw) whether or not the Inaugural Draw is used
- Each player will play 2 games of sectional play and act as a marker for 1 game
- The winner of the first game in sectional play marks the second game
- Further games commence as they become available
- One trial ends each day with four bowls qualified to enter each game
- Players shall advise the name of their coach upon checking in with the Organising Body (Tournament committee and umpire prior to the match commencing)
- Players will only be able to visit the field after that third round (round 2 & 3) is achieved
- In exceptional and limited circumstances a player may visit the marker to visit the field earlier than the 3rd round
- Non-compliance will be addressed by Law 18
- An Open Draw will be held for the next 12 players on Day 3 (Tuesday) at 8.15am to determine the draw
- Entry is open to all Bowls Australia affiliated bowlers
- Bowls Australia Ranking Points event entries only (except through Bowls Link, no other entries considered)
- All needs are the responsibility of the players
- Players must be familiar with and accept all Conditions of Play
- All other laws will conform to the laws of the sport of lawn bowls and Conditions Regulations
- These players markers will be sectioned unless you have Law 17 in Law 18 (1) will go through to each sectional day
- If a player fails to show up to a sectional play a 1st round of that round will be allocated to the affected player

- The Controlling Body of the Tweed Open Premier Singles "TOPS" will be the Club Tweed Bowls Department
- Open Mixed Singles Event
- Limited to 168 Players (84 Players for each Sectional Day)
- Dress code: BA-approved bowls attire or club uniform
- Bowls Australia Ranking Points event - Bowls Link Entry Required
- Open draw at 8.15 am for Sectional Play for Day 1 & Day 2
- Trial ends from 8.45 am (earlier if all players have checked in)
- Each section will be made up of 3 players
- All Sectional winners will play 1 round of post sectional play that day once sectional play is completed
- 32 players will qualify for the post sectional play from both Sunday & Monday's sectional games
- This will be made up of the sectional winners, and the next best players (with highest wins + margin) required to make up a round of 32 players
- Pending Entries, Sectional winners will play 1 round of post sectional play that day once sectional play is completed
- All games 21 shots up with dead ends replayed
- The Indoor Green may be used as required
- Subsequent rounds may be transferred to the Indoor Green if required due to weather or entries
- Each player will play 2 games of sectional play and act as a marker for 1 game
- The winner of the first game in sectional play marks the second game
- Further games commence as rinks become available
- One trial ends each way with four bowls permitted before each game
- Players shall advise the name of their coach upon checking in with the Controlling Body, Tournament committee and Umpire prior to the match commencing
- Players will only be able to visit the head after their third & fourth bowl (A.41) is delivered
- In exceptional and limited circumstances a player may ask the marker to visit the head earlier than this (Law A.42)
- Non-compliance will be addressed by Law 13
- An Open Draw will be held for the last 32 players on Day 3 (Tuesday) at 8.15am to determine the draw
- Entry is open to all Bowls Australia affiliated bowlers
- Bowls Australia Ranking Points event, entries only accepted through Bowls Link, no paper copies accepted
- All meals are the responsibility of the players
- Players must be familiar with and accept all Conditions of Play
- All other laws will conform to the Laws of the sport of Lawn Bowls and Domestic Regulations
- Three player sections with the sectional winner (as per Law 27 & Law 56.31.3) will go through to post sectional play
- If a bye/forfeit is in sectional play, a win + margin of that round will be allocated to the affected player
